



Board of Directors - Currently Accepting Applications; Deadline of July 1/21

The Board of Directors of the Calgary Booster Club is inviting interested candidates to submit their application for consideration as a member of the Board.

Building on over 6 decades of impact in the Calgary area, we are seeking to add individuals prepared to shape the future of support programs for young athletes and sport recognition in our city and surrounding area. The Booster Club is in transition and we are recruiting dynamic, progressive volunteers to accept this challenge to become involved, participating in the construction and execution of a new strategic plan for the organization.

The Board is led by an Executive Committee consisting of the President, three Vice Presidents, a Treasurer and Secretary. The Board currently also includes fifteen Directors at Large. Every year at the Annual General Meeting, Board vacancies are filled through an election conducted by existing Members.

There will be a minimum of one Director at Large position open for election at the 2021 Annual General Meeting to be held in September (date TBD). The Board has reviewed the skills, knowledge and background of existing Directors and determined that an individual with 1 or more strengths in the following areas would be an immediate asset to the Calgary Booster Club:

- Enthusiastic individual with a passion for amateur sport
- professional, personal, or other experience and networks within the corporate, business, and/or sport communities
- Visionary, strategic thinker who seeks out opportunities
- Strong communicator with knowledge of social media and/or experience working with public media contacts

The members of the Board of Directors are expected to attend and participate in monthly meetings conducted from September through June. All Directors are assigned a role in preparing and executing the Calgary Booster Club's annual Sports Gala in April. Furthermore, Directors are expected to contribute to the Calgary Booster Club as a member of a working committee. Candidates for nomination to the Board of Directors must be at least 18 years of age and a resident of Calgary or surrounding area.
